

See It, Talk About It

WHAT DO YOU SEE?

Ask your child to name what they see around them.

HOW IS IT USED?

Talk about the objects or things your child named is used. Relate it back to real life experiences.

WHERE CAN WE FIND IT?

Ask your child where the object can be found or where they could be used?

WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE?

Use descriptive words such as colors, size, shape, quantity to talk about how things look.

FOLLOW YOUR CHILD'S LEAD

Ask the right questions, and then let your child answer naturally. It is not about right or wrong answers but keeping them engaged in conversation. Encouraging them to talk.

HAVE FUN!

Speech is a family thing. Get involved. Make it fun. Communicate with your child in an exciting way and make all family members a part of it.
